



Any district personnel may serve as a test administrator if they hold valid education credentials (such as a Texas educator certificate permit), or if they are supervised by a district professional who holds the appropriate credential. All district and campus personnel who participate in state mandated testing or handle or have access to secure test materials must be trained at least once in proper testing procedures and have signed an Oath of Test Security and Confidentiality.

10. What do I do if a student who is receiving remote instruction does not participate in the December 2021 STAAR administration?

For any eligible student receiving remote instruction who does not go to the campus or designated testing site to take a STAAR EOC assessment in December 2021, the district should treat them like any other student who does not test.

- x For students taking STAAR EOC assessment for the first time in December 2021, use "S" for Score.
- x For students taking STAAR EOC retest in December 2021, use "O" for Other.
